Room Parents	1 hour weekly (easy to do remotely, check in with teachers at dropoff)	Coordinate and support the efforts and events within the room and school collectively, with the support and input of the Parents Group and Staff. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Supports teachers by communicating important information to all of the parents, mainly through email. • Corresponds with all of parent volunteers below to ensure their roles and responsibilities are filled and needed volunteers are filled. Coordinates for substitutes as needed. • This person is the essential link between the teachers, parents, and the Parents Group. Communication is key!
Pizza Lunch Helpers	2 hours (4 times a year)	On the classroom's designated Fridays (see the pizza lunch calendar), pizza needs to be served to the younger children in the classrooms and served to the elementary students in the lunch court on designated pizza days. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Distribute pizza, fruit, and veggies to the younger children in the classrooms and elementary students on the lunch court on designated pizza days. • Help set-up and cleanup the pizza boxes as well as help clean up the kitchen when finished.
Teacher Appreciation	10 hours total (throughout the year)	This volunteer is responsible for organizing the recognition and encouragement of the classrooms' teachers. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Collect contributions from the classroom families and coordinate gifts for special events (birthdays, holidays, end of the year) • Be the point of contact for the school-wide Teacher and Staff Appreciation Week
Halloween Carnival	5 hours total	Work together with volunteers from all of the classrooms and Parent Group to assist with the planning of the Halloween Carnival. On the day of the carnival each room has a booth that needs to be staffed by parent volunteers. This volunteer will help coordinate their classroom volunteers. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Set-up AND close down the classroom Halloween booth on the day of the carnival. • Coordinate with the Room Parent in order to generate parent volunteers for the classroom Halloween booth.
Holiday Helpers	5 hours total	During the Thanksgiving and the Holiday Season we like to give to the less fortunate. This volunteer would help collect and coordinate the classroom's donation activities. We also assist the teachers with Holiday program outfits and celebrations; we need to ask the teachers how we can help.

Garden Parent	1 hour weekly (flexible scheduling)	Each classroom has a designated area at the school for a garden. This parent will work with the teacher to coordinate planting/maintenance of the class garden. There are designated funds from the parents group for garden expenses. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Purchase plants for the classroom garden (using parents group designated funds) • Water daily and fertilize weekly • Light pruning as needed • Once every month, pull out small groups of children to be your garden apprentices.
Yearbook Photo Coordinator	4 hours total (throughout the year)	This volunteer will remind parents to take pictures during events and field trips during the year and will collect them for the yearbook collage page. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In March, our school Yearbook editor, Ms. Jennifer, will be in touch with directions and a website to design and submit our class yearbook page.
Library Support	1 hour monthly (flexible scheduling)	The library is a great way to be involved at MBMA. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Visit the public library once a month to check out books relevant to the theme, artist, composer, season, and or holiday. • Parent volunteers can work with the librarian and teacher to find time to bring students into the school library.
Spring Fundraiser Art-By-Children (ABC Art)	5 hours total	Each classroom supports a student created art or craft for the Spring Gala Fundraiser Auction. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Come up with a class art project • Purchase all of the materials necessary (using Parents Group designated funds) • Donate time needed (about 5 hours total- possibly broken up into several days) to pull out small groups of children at a time in order for all children to contribute to the project.
Science Expert	1-2 hours per month	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Collaborate with teacher to prepare a simple science experiment that relates to the monthly science topic • Once a month, pull out small groups of children to present the science experiment.
Calendar Correspondent	1 hour per month	Work with teachers to create a monthly calendar, which includes all of the classroom and school activities. The teacher will provide a draft near the end of the month, and you will create an attractive electronic version to share with families.
